Bluewater District School Board Receives “Electricity Retrofit Incentive Program” Funding

Chesley, ON – Bluewater District School Board has received a cheque in the amount of \$79,330.52 from Westario Power Inc. as part of the “Electricity Retrofit Incentive Program”.
