



Bluewater District School Board (BWDSB) is looking for additional members for their Special Education Advisory Committee and invites local organizations/associations representing or supporting parents of students with special education needs that operate within the jurisdiction of the BWDSB to apply to serve on the committee until November 30, 2018.

SEAC is a statutory committee of the Board providing advice about Special Education programs and services available to students of Bluewater.

The Committee will include up to 12 representative members selected from the nominations. Eligible nominees are:

- members or staff of qualified organizations/associations,
- Canadian citizens of a minimum of 18 years of age,
- residents of the board and individuals qualified to vote for Trustees of BWDSB.
- Employees of BWDSB are not eligible for membership on the SEAC.

SEAC meets approximately 10 times during the school year usually on the fourth Monday of the month at the Education Centre in Chesley starting at 9:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.

Organizations/associations are asked to submit their letter of nomination as follows:

- Submit on letterhead the name of the individual nominated by the organization/association providing information regarding how that individual may be contacted
- Confirm that the individual is a Canadian Citizen and a minimum of 18 years of age, resident of the BWDSB community and qualified to vote for Trustees of the BWDSB
- Similarly, provide the name of an alternative representative that may attend meetings when the representative is unable to attend;
