

# Facility Planning Strategy – Saugeen Shores and Area Schools

## Background

As part of Bluewater District School Board's (BWDSB) facility planning, staff have identified enrolment growth in the Saugeen Shores area schools. Staff have examined the future projected enrolment in the Saugeen Shores area in order to plan appropriately and ensure sufficient pupil spaces exist in the area. Northport Elementary School programs for JK to grade 6 for English programming, Port Elgin - Saugeen Central School programs for grades JK to grade 6 for English and French Immersion, and Saugeen District Senior School programs for grade 7 to grade 12 for English and French Immersion. Other schools in the immediate area are G.C. Huston Public School that programs JK to grade 8, and Paisley Central School that programs for JK to grade 8.

#### **Current Status**

The current October enrolment at the three Saugeen Shores schools is at 104% utilization: 119% at Northport Elementary School, 90% at Port Elgin-Saugeen Central School, and 119% in the elementary panel at Saugeen District Senior School. Portables are being used to accommodate the over utilization:

- Northport Elementary School currently has four portables on site
- Port Elgin-Saugeen Central School currently has no portables on site
- Saugeen District Senior School currently has two portables on site

### **Projected Status**

Enrolment in the Saugeen Shores area is expected to increase in the coming years due to a high level of new construction. For 2023-24, the utilization of the three Saugeen Shores schools is expected to increase to 109%.

In the short term, BWDSB believes that the schools can meet the need of projected student enrolment with the placement of portables and the option of converting additional space within the school to temporary classroom space; however, a plan is required for beyond the short term.

BWDSB will be submitting a business case to the Ministry of Education for a larger replacement school for Northport Elementary School. Further communication with the municipality will reaffirm their endorsement for this plan.

Looking at the next several years, alternate accommodation strategies may need to be considered to accommodate enrolment in the area. Boundary reviews or the designation of holding schools outside the current boundaries for new developments could be considered to alleviate the pressure at Northport Elementary School.
