1.0 RATIONALE

Time allocation guidelines will provide principals with a framework within which to approach school organization.

2.0 PROCEDURE

- 2.1 While the subject areas are separated for the purpose of the chart in Appendix A, the opportunities for overlap and integration exist and are strongly encouraged.
 - 2.1.1 These time allocations represent daily equivalent times and are presented as general guidelines.
 - 2.1.2 Time allocations should be adjusted in response to specific learning needs of individuals or clusters of students.
 - 2.1.3 Actual time allocation may vary.
 - 2.1.4 Instructional time will not exceed 300 minutes per day.
