



Beavercrest Community School Update

Background

Bluewater District School Board (BWDSB) received approved funding for a new 236 pupil school to be placed in the town of Markdale to replace the current Beavercrest Community School. Funding in the amount of \$6.4 million will be used for a new school with additional funding of \$2.1 million used to create two childcare rooms and two EarlyON rooms at the same location.

On November 6, 2020 the ministry approved the facility space template that was submitted to the ministry for review and approval. The approval indicates that the total number of pupil places being planned for is consistent with the ministry approved scope for this school. In addition, the child care space identified on the space template falls within the child care space requirements.

Update

Staff continue to work with the architect, the adjacent land developer, and the ministry to move this project forward. We continue to keep the webpage up to date.

To recap, on April 8, 2021, the purchase of the additional lands was finalized and recently BWDSB has an agreement in place with the land owner for construction access to the site. This will allow us to continue to operate the existing school without sharing the existing site with construction vehicles.

School designs prepared by +VG Architects have been shared with the public. We did receive a few questions and responses were shared. An updated detailed design has been provided and posted to the site.

Financial Impact

As previously reported current estimates are expected to be higher than the funding commitment given the construction environment and the impact of Covid-19. The project team has worked with the ministry to determine feasible options to move forward. As a result, the ministry has recommended that an Approval To Proceed (ATP) be submitted with BWDSB lead letter and Architect comments on cost saving measures taken to date. The ministry will review the information and provide direction in the upcoming months. Once the ATP is received, we will proceed to tender.

Recommendation:
