## Maker Math Camp

- Focus on the big concepts in number sense and algebra
- Enjoy opportunities to learn, create, and explore math through the subjects of science, technology, engineering, and the arts (STEAM)
- Develop new learning skills to prepare for secondary school as a confident, active learner
- Work with a numeracy teacher to strengthen math skills

## Epic Journey Literacy Camp

- Focus on reading comprehension, skills, and strategies
- Develop core literacy skills, and social emotional learning skills based on student interests
- Engage in a variety of writing activities
- Enjoy opportunities to learn, and explore literacy through creative activities
- Work with a reading teacher to strengthen reading skills

## Landing Success Indigenous Grade 8 and 9 Program

Students who self-identify as Indigenous are invited to attend a unique program using a land-based approach to literacy, numeracy, and science.

**Students may earn a reach ahead Outdoor Education (PAD1O) credit.**

- Work with elders and local artists to explore math, literacy, and science concepts.
- Learn about stewardship through a land-based learning model.
