Teachers and students now able to have direct Learn360 access

Learn360? It's an Online Video and Media Library



Up to now teachers have only had access to Learn360 media files through the OERB. While the OERB portal will still work, that method did not allow teachers to create playlists.



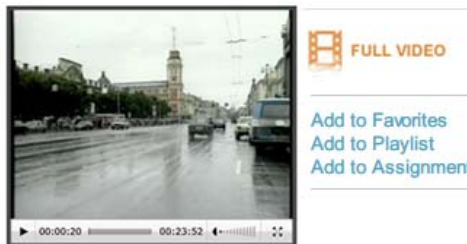
Media available at Learn360.com may be streamed or downloaded. When streaming, the media is played as the data arrives and is opened. Downloading is the process where all of a media file's data is transferred from a website to a local drive before the media is opened

MY PREFERENCES

By setting preferences, the download and streaming rates can be adjusted. The higher the rate the better quality video. Note: if you stream at 1.5MBps, you may slow down other internet traffic in your building. If you download at 1.5MBps, you should do so outside of school hours.

BROWSE PLAYLISTS [New Playlist]

Playlists allow teachers to group a number of media items to be played in order. Once a playlist has been created, links to media files can be added.



Media files may be saved as favourites as well. When played, playlists open in a viewer and can be enlarged to full screen.



Favourites and playlists are accessed through MyLearning360. (after picking grade and subjects the first time). You may also see playlists shared by others.
